DO YOU HAVE TO BE A BOAT OWNER TO BELONG TO THE CLUB?

Absolutely not, currently over 40% of our membership does not own a boat.

DO YOU OFFER SOCIAL MEMBERSHIPS?

Yes, the Club currently offers Regular, Mariner and Social/Dining memberships. Regular Membership entitles members to all of the benefits and services of the Club with leasing a slip in the Yacht Basin.
